

Application is invited for postdoctoral Research Associate to join the CEPAM (research lab UNS and CNRS) and work in the interdisciplinary, collaborative project entitled Zoomathia. The local project team consists of ten advanced students, engineers, lecturers or professors of two labs (<u>CEPAM</u>, <u>I3S</u>) working independently and in collaboration with each other and the director of the project.
